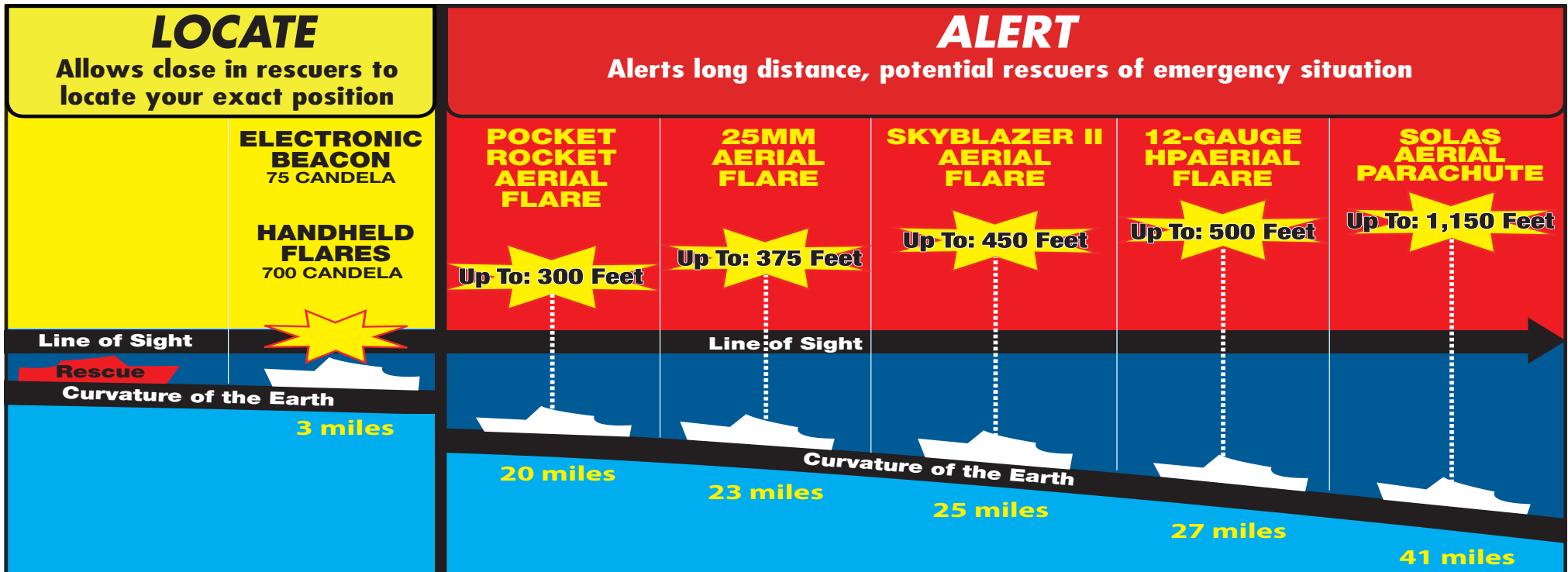

## UNDERSTANDING LOCATE VS ALERT SIGNALS

Due to the curvature of the earth and line of sight restrictions, potential rescuers can only see handheld electronic light and handheld flares (**LOCATE SIGNALS**) up to 3 miles away. Anyone beyond 3 miles will not see Locate Signals. This is why aerial flares (**ALERT SIGNALS**) should also be on your boat. **ALERT SIGNALS** can be seen as far away as 41 miles to alert potential rescuers you require assistance. As rescuers approach, **LOCATE SIGNALS** help pinpoint your exact location.
