

URGENT SAFETY RECALL AND PRODUCT QUARANTINE

Skyblazer II Red XLT Aerial Signals

November 26, 2025

Orion Safety Products is voluntarily recalling the **Skyblazer II Red XLT Aerial Signals ("XLTs")** after receiving a report of an XLT igniting without the safety cap being removed or the ignition cord being pulled. The report indicates the flare burned in place but did not launch. There were no reported injuries.

The retail products impacted by this recall are:

Product Numbers 769 and 859 with an Expiration Date of August 2028 through April 2029

As the investigation continues, Orion is directing all customers to:

- Immediately stop using any XLTs with the Expiration Dates noted above.
- Quarantine all impacted XLTs and store the product in a safe and secure location away from combustible products until further notice.
